Structure

FLP Leadership Council and Associates

An assembly of key leaders who will provide oversight, guidance, support and challenge to the 'future leaders'. Council members and Associates include:

- Directors and CEOs from the renewable and environment sectors.
- Industry leaders from various sectors who recognise the need for urgent action and can offer support, insight and inspiration.
- An array of individuals providing talks and mentoring opportunities.

FLP Delegates

High performing individuals who are recognised for their leadership potential, passion to drive change and whose participation is sponsored by their respective organisations.

Framework

Following selection, there are three phases to the FLP for delegates:

Foundation

The Foundation Phase will equip delegates with essential leadership skills and the mindset to lead now and into the future. Over three months delegates attend four highly engaging and interactive modules delivered virtually and accompanied by reflective self learning and a one-to-one personal resilience session.

Application

In the Application Phase delegates are invited to deliver a project over six months. The FLP Leadership Council will provide guidance on projects, which will demonstrate tangible and explicit progress in driving businesses towards Net Zero. The Application Phase begins with a strategy and project planning workshop, followed by monthly Leadership Mentoring Groups which will include site visits, along with talks on topics such as mitigation, adaptation and commercial awareness.

Aspiration

Following graduation at the end of the Application Phase, delegates are invited to join an ongoing network of leaders who collaborate and assemble periodically to review progress towards Net Zero, challenge each other and drive accountability.
